Raymond R. Cannon, Sr. age 83 passed away suddenly Thursday, September 25, 2015 in Leesburg, Florida. Ray was born in New York City and moved to the Plantation at Leesburg in 2010 from New Smyrna Beach, Florida. Before retiring he had a 31 year career with Grumman Aircraft. He was a proud veteran of the U.S. Navy and served during the Korean War. He loved to be active and was a member of the Plantation Pickleball Association, Plantation Dart League, and the Eustis Elks Club. He also enjoyed flying radio controlled planes and was a member of the Pear Park Pilots, and the Southern Eagles Pilots Clubs. Ray is remembered by those closest to him for his loving, fun, generous, and entertaining personality. He took joy in making those around him smile. 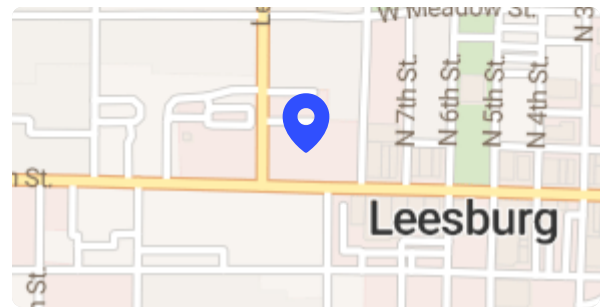

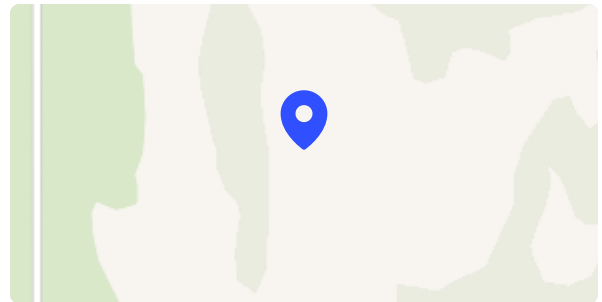

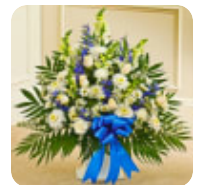
