John graduated from the American University in Washington, DC in 1963, with a BS in Public Administration. Attended Baltimore City College High School with the Class of 1954.

John served in the U.S. Army from 1958 to 1961 with the 508th Military Police Battalion in Munich, Germany. In addition to his military duties, he was also assigned as a translator for several NATO exercises in France.

John gained a lot of practical experience working while attending college for several large organizations. In 1969, he joined Air Canada and progressed rapidly, becoming an Airport Supervisor, Personnel Supervisor, and Personnel Administration Manager.
