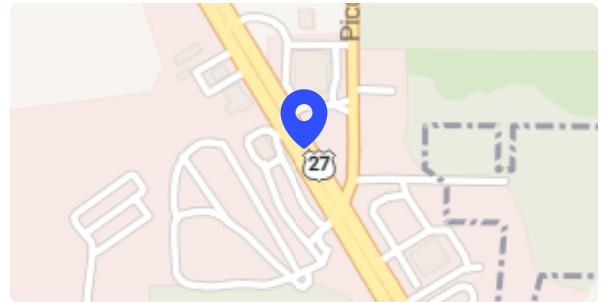

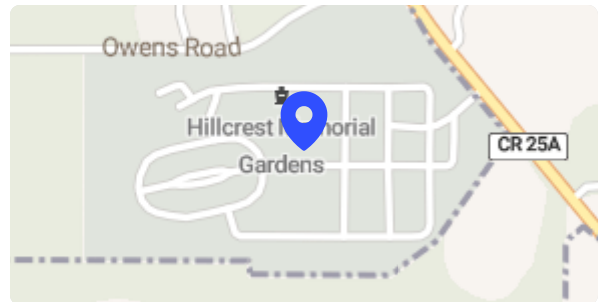

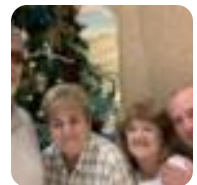
Diane Fedell posted:
