She graduated from Heights High in 1963 and attended Kent State University before getting married to Alan Weiner. They had two children together, Raymond and Amanda. They divorced and several years later Judy met the love of her life Lenny Clark. They wed in 1983, bringing Lenny's daughter Martha into the family. Judy passed away June 28, 2024 in The Villages, Florida.

Judy had a bubbly warm personality and a great sense of humor. She was generally smiling and laughing. She was quick witted and always interested in learning new things, and moving on from old things. No one could count the amount of classes she took, or the amount of jobs she went through. The family joked about her being a founding member of the w-2 of the month club. She and Lenny moved often and owned several businesses over the years. 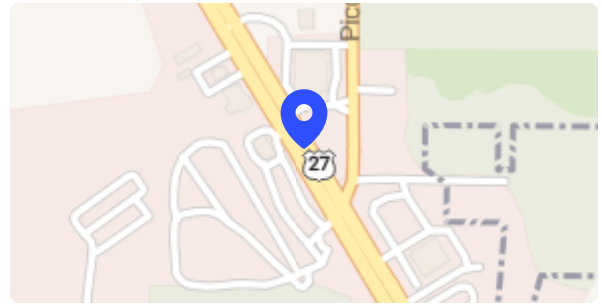
