Clarence enjoyed taking cruises with his late wife of 73 years Jean and together they took cruises throughout the Caribbean, Panama Canal and Alaska just to name a few. The foundation of the joy in his life however was his family, and he relished every minute he got to spend with them. A few days before his passing he wrote his daughters a note proclaiming that "he had a good life and that they were loved."
