Ronald Carlton Trump passed away on Thursday July 8, 2010 at the age of 76. He was born on August 28, 1933 in Nocatee, FL to the late John and Thelma Trump. Ronald was a 1951 graduate of Miami High, served his country in the U.S. Navy, and returned to graduate, in 1960, from University of Florida with an Electrical Engineering degree. He retired from Honeywell Aero Space in Clearwater, FL as a staff Engineer. Ronald also found time to serve as a Certified Lay Speaker and member of the Webster United Methodist Church, volunteered as a Chaplain at Leesburg Regional Medical Center, and also volunteered at People Helpers with First Baptist Church, Leesburg, FL.
